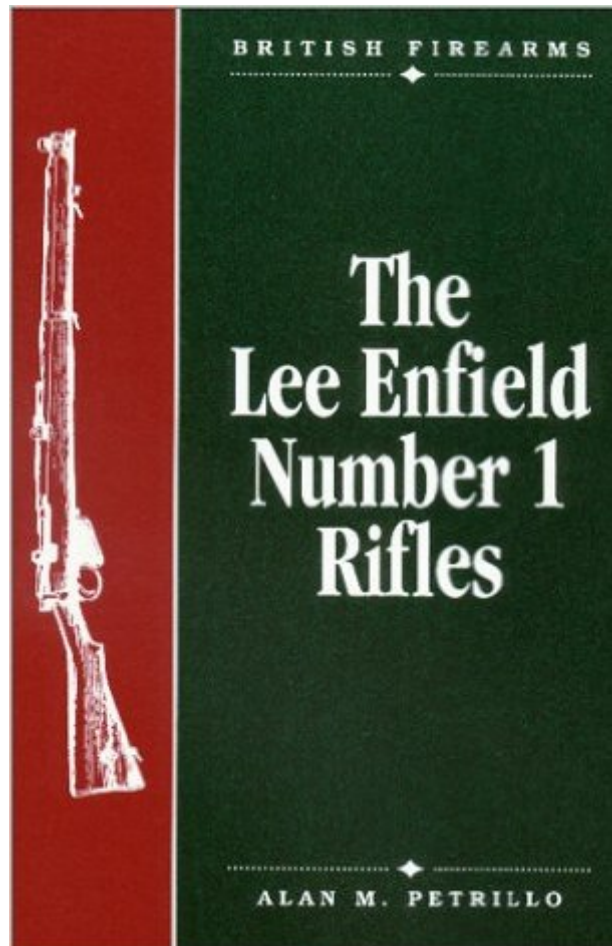

I was disappointed with the book in so much I'd expected much more information. The content was the same old, very basic, outline of the rifles history and it reminded me of something that you might have once seen in a junior high school library such was the level of information. I would recommend this book to someone that had little or no idea of the history of Lee Enfield rifles as a teaser to further reading, such as Stratton's British Enfield Rifles, Vol 1.
